Addenda to Schedule O, Supplemental Information Conflict of Interest Policy

An employee is expected to conduct WCPE business with complete honesty and total integrity in accordance with highest ethical standards and to act in compliance with all federal, state and local laws. An employee in violation of WCPE's policies will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination of employment.

<u>Unacceptable Actions</u> -- Each employee should be aware that there are certain actions that may result in disciplinary action. These actions include, but are not limited to: Theft or dishonesty, including falsification of time records or furnishing false or incomplete information on WCPE records; discussing or revealing to individuals or entities any proprietary information of a confidential nature which was obtained in the course of employment; disclosing confidential or privileged information to another employee except to those employees who are authorized to receive such information; using confidential information for personal advantage; deliberate or negligent damages to WCPE property, or the property of others; allowing damage, either deliberate or through negligence, to WCPE property; bringing, or attempting to bring onto WCPE premises, any firearm, dangerous weapon, explosive material, or instruments intended to coerce or inflict bodily injury; creation of safety or health hazards or failure to comply with procedures provided for employee and public protection; possession, use, or being under the influence of drugs prohibited by law; gambling, fighting, assault, disorderly conduct, uncivilized or unprofessional behavior including using significant or intensively abusive or obscene language or gestures; insubordination to, interference with, or failure to properly, efficiently, or professionally carry out any reasonable work or related order of management; excessive or unjustified absences, excessive tardiness or failure to notify WCPE for absences; leaving the work place during scheduled work hours for other than assigned duties without management permission, except for emergencies; failing to disclose a conflict of interest, real or implied; receiving any rebate, kickback, discount, commission, reciprocal agreement or any other form of reward from any individual or organization furnishing to WCPE supplies or products where it is apparent the size or value of such consideration is to influence the recipient's decision to use or purchase the donor's services, supplies or products, or to provide some special service such as promotional broadcast time, but not business lunches and dinners or other such minor amenities which are considered normal in the course of business; receiving direct or indirect undisclosed payment or other valuable consideration to influence program selection; and, employees and their family members are not permitted to participate in contests offered by WCPE. In addition, knowledge of a breach of the above by another employee and failure to report the matter to management makes one an accomplice.

• <u>Conflicts of Interest</u> -- WCPE is a non-profit public broadcaster and, due to the nature of broadcasting, is under constant public scrutiny. All WCPE employees are expected to conduct their business and personal affairs in such manner and with such ethics and integrity that no conflict of interest, real or implied, can be construed. A conflict of interest shall be deemed to exist whenever an employee or member of their families has any financial interest, direct or indirect, in any business furnishing services, supplies, or products to WCPE. While WCPE recognizes that employees may choose to supplement their income through a secondary job, there are instances when such a job may be considered a conflict of interest. Therefore, all WCPE employees must receive their supervisor's approval for such employment and thereafter to annually update their supervisor about any employment outside WCPE. Any changes or additions to an employee's outside employment status must be reported to the appropriate supervisor within a week of the change.

For All, But Especially for Control Room Staff -- WCPE prohibits any employee from accepting or agreeing to accept from any person or entity other than WCPE any money, service or other valuable consideration in return for or in connection with the broadcast of any matter over WCPE. Employees are not permitted to participate, directly or indirectly, in the practice of payola and or plugola. "Payola" is the direct and undisclosed payment of money or other valuable consideration to influence program selection or promote a product or service. "Plugola" is the indirect benefit flowing to an employee to influence program selection or favorably mention or display someone or something in parts of a program.

There are always two people available to privately hear complaints and/or concerns about station activities. Two people are chosen so that it is more likely that an employee or volunteer could speak with at least one of them. The above paragraphs come from the station handbook which is posted at the reception desk; in addition, each employee is given a copy of same at the time of hire.
