Previously funded projects and programs have included individual and group music lessons, educational community concerts, master classes with highly regarded performers, and funds to acquire new instruments. Grants awarded are typically between \$1,000 and \$3,000, supporting multiple organizations each year. Financial support for the Education Fund comes from members of The Classical Station.
